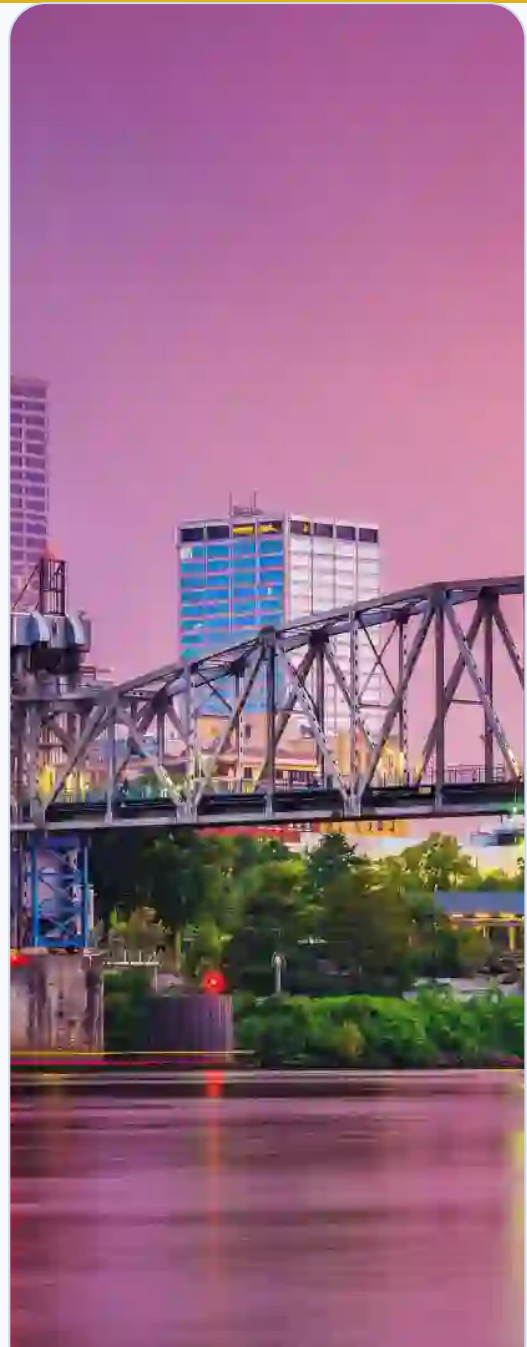

GAP**Independent recognition**

Priority improvement area: awards, press, expert letters, citations, patents, publications or public product impact.

REVIEW**Family planning**

Spouse and child strategy depends on immigrant stage, documents and timing.

**CV PRIORITY**

Quantify product impact, leadership scope, public benefit and expert validation.

First 7 days

Prepare immigration-format CV, passport, degree records, role proof and a project impact list.

02

Next 30 days

Build an EB-2 NIW evidence matrix with quantified work impact, expert letter targets and proposed endeavor notes.

03

Before filing

Advisor validates national-interest narrative, document consistency, family strategy and route alternatives.

04

Service conversion

Move into the evidence matrix and documentation package once the advisor confirms route strength.

Gather supporting evidence such as awards, publications, memberships, and recommendation letters.

3

Submit Form I-140

File the EB-1A immigrant petition with USCIS; self-petition is allowed.

4

Proceed with status adjustment or consular processing

File Form I-485 in the U.S. or DS-260 abroad once the petition is approved.

5

Attend biometrics and interview

Complete necessary appointments with USCIS or at a U.S. consulate.

6

Obtain Green Card

Receive U.S. permanent residency upon approval of your EB-1A application.

Identity and Civil Documents

- Valid passport and government-issued photo ID
- Birth certificate and proof of civil status

Proof of Extraordinary Ability

- National or international awards and recognition certificates
- Membership in professional associations with selective criteria
- Published articles or media coverage highlighting achievements
- Evidence of judging work or contributions of others
- Proof of original contributions with major impact in the field
- Authorship of scholarly or creative publications

Supporting Evidence

- Recommendation letters from credible experts in the field
- Proof of intent to continue work in the area of expertise
- Contracts, business plans, or U.S. project evidence supporting future activity

RISK CONTROLS

Issues to verify before engagement

The objective is to reduce weak evidence, inconsistent documents and strategy mismatch.

01

EB-1A petitions are evidence-heavy and require detailed documentation.

02

Weak or repetitive recommendation letters may trigger an RFE.

03

A clear presentation of achievements improves approval chances.

04

Submit verifiable, well-organized evidence for all claims.

05

Translate and certify non-English documents.

06

Maintain valid U.S. status when filing for adjustment of status.

Why EB-2 NIW is the primary direction

Alternatives are useful only if the client's evidence, capital, sponsor, country preference or timing supports them.

Can become relevant if public recognition, awards, judging, media, patents or citations are stronger.

TEMPORARY ROUTE OPTION**O-1A Extraordinary Ability**

Useful if a U.S. petitioner and strong achievement evidence are available.

EMPLOYER-LED OPTION**H-1B Specialty Occupation**

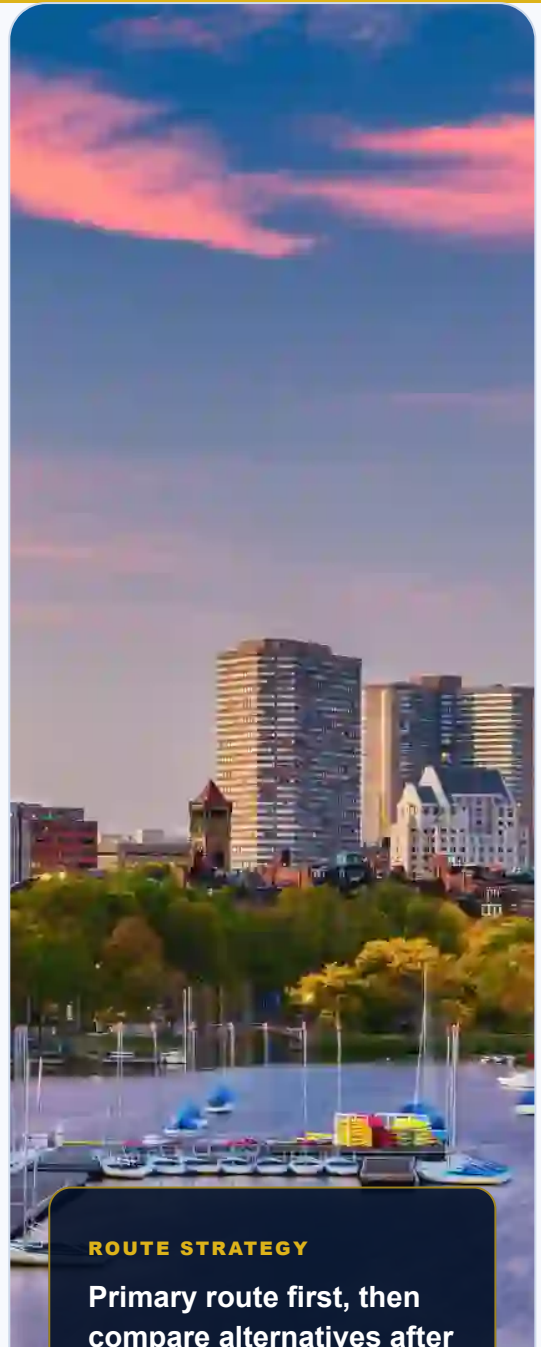
Requires qualifying employer strategy and timing review for cap or cap-exempt pathways.

INVESTMENT ALTERNATIVE**EB-5 Investor Route**

Relevant only if the client chooses capital-led Green Card planning.

ROUTE STRATEGY

Primary route first, then compare alternatives after advisor review and document verification.

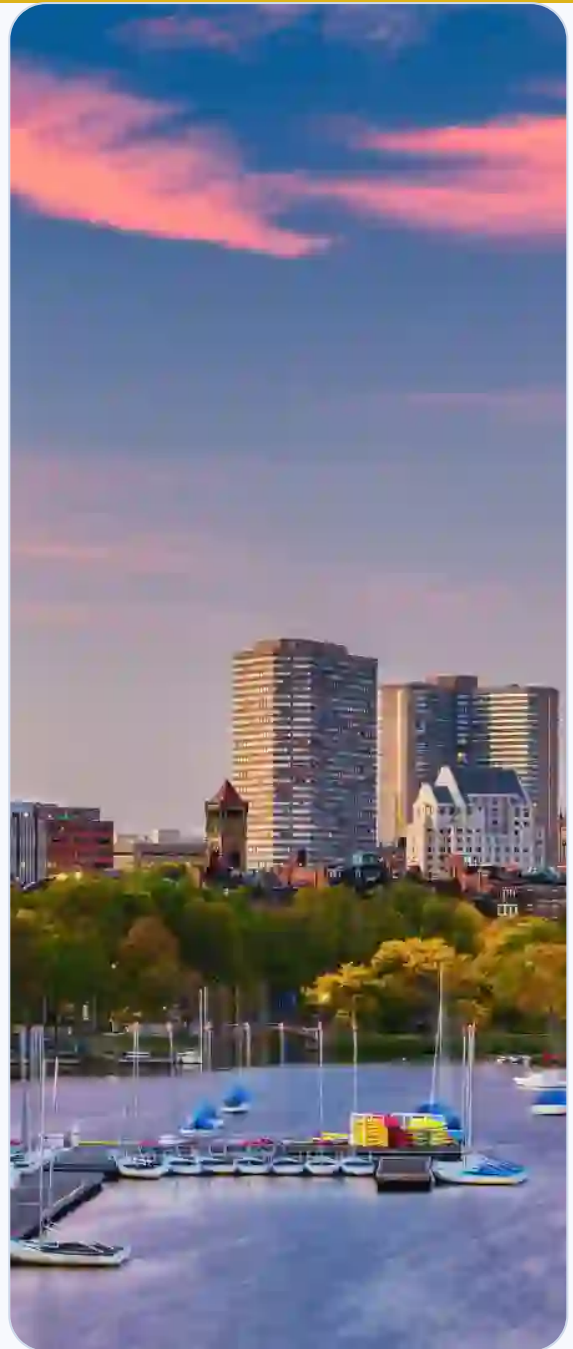
